

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FALL A LEAGUE BASEBALL)

1. When are sign ups?

Registration will be open from the first week of June through the first week of August.

2. Where are sign ups?

Online www.parksattexasstar.com and click on the link for A league Registration.

3. What if I want my child to play up a division?

All players will play in the age division according to how old they will be as of April 30 of the following year. A parent may make the request for a player to play up an age division if they desire. Any player moving up before they are of age must be cleared by the Athletic Coordinator. Please call 817-685-1838

4. How are teams formed?

Fall teams will be formed using rosters from the previous year's Spring season, blind draw and the buddy system. A player may always return to his previous spring team as long as the team remains in the same age division.

5. Can my kids play on the same team?

Siblings of the same age division will always play together unless being on different teams is requested by their parents. Please make sure to specify on the registration form that they are buddies so we can link them together

6. How long is the season?

Season starts the first week of September and will end the last week of October (weather depending)

7. When do practices start?

Practice will begin in Mid-August once registration is complete.

8. When are games?

Games are on Saturdays and during the week.

9. Where are games and practices?

Games are played at the Parks at Texas Star and Practices are held at Bob Eden Park, West Park, HEB Schools or Midway Fields

10. Can my child be put on a team with his or her friends?

For those players that are registering as individuals in the “A” Division, the buddy system can be utilized. If two players would like to be assigned to the same team, they can make that request on their registration form. All buddy requests must be reciprocating and may not be in violation of the above rules.

11. What equipment do players need?

Glove, age appropriate shoes/cleats (no steel cleats allowed), (personal bat and helmet are optional)

12. What other costs are involved?

The league provides a hat and jersey. Teams may decide to purchase matching pants, belts and socks.

13. What do I do to sign up as a Coach?

Anyone interested in coaching a team must fill out a Coaches application and pass the background check. Background checks are done through TAAF.

14. How do I know what league my child is allowed to play in?

Fall registration is based off of the child’s age as of April 30th of the following year

15. Can my child play in a different league?

Children cannot play down an age division from their actual age but may play up one age division
